Business Services is requesting Board approval to replace expiring copier leases located at Discovery High School, Liberty Middle School, Woodburn Elementary, Prune Hill Elementary, Lacamas Lake Elementary, Grass Valley Elementary, the ZAC HR department, and the ZAC workroom with new Konica Minolta machines from Pacific Office Automation. All machines will have similar functionality to the current machines. The total lease amount for all 8 machines is \$940.27 (plus sales tax) per month for 60 months. This cost will come out of the general fund and is \$371.79 less per month than the total of the expiring leases.

The Technology Department is requesting Board approval to enter into a 4-year lease for laptops that will replace existing equipment that has reached the end of its useful life. The lease will include new 27-inch monitors with built-in web cameras and docking stations for the classrooms. The price of the HP laptops is 4% more than what we paid for the Dell laptops in 2019. The total of the lease payments is \$1,411,736.21 (including sales tax). We have set up the payment schedule to coincide with the collection of technology levy funds.
